

St. Mark's Prayer Calendar for July 2018

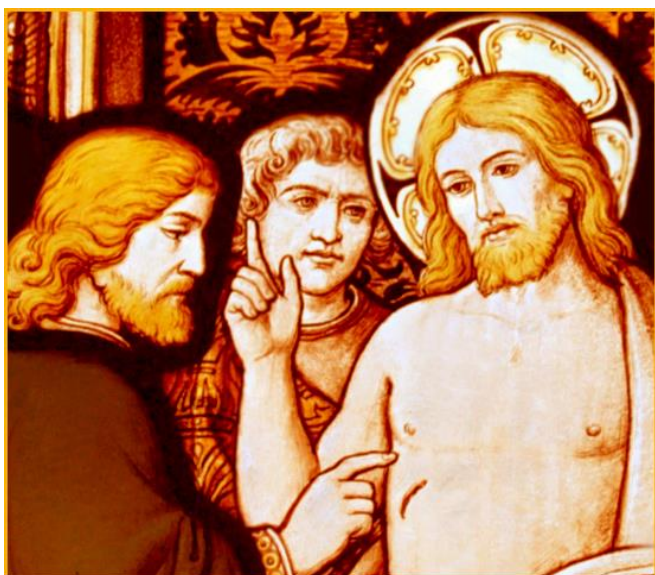
He took her by the hand and said to her, "Little girl, get up! And immediately the girl got up and began to walk about.
